Blackbird Temporary 138kV Extension Project

Dear Lynn Fairclough,

You are receiving this letter because we wanted to let you know about a proposed transmission project in Brown Township, Carroll County.

AEP Ohio representatives plan to build less than .2 miles of temporary 138-kilovolt (kV) power line extending from the Windsor-Canton 138-kV transmission line to a customer's delivery point. Company officials need to build the transmission line following a customer's request and to provide power to their facility.

Company representatives filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB) as Blackbird Temporary 138kV Extension Project, Case No. 25-0872-EL-BLN. If approved, construction is expected to begin in late 2025 and concludes early 2027. The temporary line is expected to remain in place for more than one year. A separate request for permanent service will be filed with the OPSB at a later date.

Enclosed is a digital copy of the Letter of Notification, which we must submit to the OPSB when we make certain changes to our transmission facilities. The submission complies with Rule 4906-6-01, et. seq., of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility awaits OPSB review. Please make this Letter of Notification available to the public. We are also communicating with landowners in the project area.
